## MOTION TO WITHDRAW MOTION FOR A STAY IN LIGHT OF LAPSE OF APPROPRIATIONS

In accordance with the Federal Defendants' motion to stay briefing deadlines, Doc. No. 32, the Federal Defendants hereby file this notice of withdrawal of that motion and state the following:

- 1. On January 22, 2018, the Federal Defendants filed a motion to stay in light of lapse of appropriations, seeking a stay of the briefing schedule in this case. *See* Doc. No. 32 at 2. Undersigned counsel stated that as soon as Congress has appropriated funds for the Department or enacted another continuing resolution, he would notify the Court. *Id*.
- 2. Consistent with the Federal Defendants' motion to stay, undersigned counsel hereby notifies the Court that on the evening of January 22, 2018, the President signed into law the Extension of Continuing Appropriations Act of 2018, which restored appropriations to the Department of Justice until February 8, 2018. Accordingly, undersigned counsel is authorized to resume working on the above-captioned matter.

Accordingly, the Federal Defendants, after consultation with opposing counsel, are withdrawing the pending motion to stay deadlines.
