Declaration of María Araceli Gonzales Flores

- 1. My name is María Araceli Gonzales Flores. I am a 22 year-old Mexican woman who resides in New York City.
- 2. I worked at Ramco and National Discount, retail stores located at 190-192 Dyckman Street, New York, New York, 10040, from approximately October 8, 2003 until I was constructively discharged on approximately January 2004. My duties included but were not limited to working as a cashier, helping customers, unpacking and stacking merchandise, sewing and ironing merchandise, cleaning the store, and going to the bank.
- 3. Albert Palacci, the owner of the retail stores and my manager, sexually harassed me and sexually assaulted me on more than one occasion.
- 4. Mr. Palacci further mistreated me by not paying me the minimum wage or overtime. During the entire course of my employment, Mr. Palacci only paid me \$40.00 a day. I usually worked from approximately 9:45 a.m. until 7:30 p.m., six days a week.
- 5. On many occasions, Mr. Palacci touched my buttocks, tried to hug me, and put his hands on my waist. On several occasions, he also rubbed his body against mine.
- 6. When I asked Mr. Palacci for permission to take time off to go to the gynecologist, Mr. Palacci made an obscene gesture with his hands and said, "I can check you out."
- 7. Mr. Palacci watched pornographic videos in his office. On one occasion, I went to Mr. Palacci's office to retrieve my purse, where Mr. Palacci insisted employees store all bags, and saw Mr. Palacci watching a pornographic video.
- 8. Mr. Palacci told me that if I was "good," he would buy me lingerie. I rejected this proposition.
- 9. Mr. Palacci regularly told me that I had to do everything he wanted me to do.
- 10. Mr. Palacci called me derogatory names on several occasions.
- 11. Mr. Palacci made the working conditions at the stores so difficult and unpleasant that I felt compelled to stop working at the stores. In or about January 2004, I stopped working at the stores.
- 12. By the conduct described herein, I believe that I was subjected to gender discrimination.
- 13. The foregoing is a brief summary of my experiences and is not intended to be an

exhaustive account.

14. I swear or affirm, under penalty of perjury, that the above is true and correct.
