To follow on our conversation, I have been advised that the FBI interviewed Mr. Mohamed in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, in 2010 regarding some national security concerns. The FBI is currently interested in whether Mr. Mohamed would be willing to submit to a voluntary interview on issues not connected to the No Fly litigation and not connected to Mr. Mohamed's status vis-à-vis the No Fly List. If he is willing, the FBI asks that he contact Supervisory Special Agent Sean Moore at 206-622-0460. Your other questions, if Mr. Mohamed wishes to raise them, are best directed to SSA Moore.

We understand that Elias Mohamed, one of our seven clients no longer on the No Fly List as of last October, recently received an email notification from the U.S. consulate in Jeddah. That notification requested that Mr. Mohamed schedule a time late next week for a meeting at the consulate to “update” him on his “travel status.” Mr. Mohamed does not know how the consulate obtained his email address, as he does not recall ever corresponding with or providing his contact information to anyone there.

We would appreciate an explanation as to why he was contacted in this manner and what specifically is to be conveyed in this “update.” We also emphasize that any communications with our clients that relate to the matters at issue in this lawsuit must be directed to counsel.
