Plaintiffs are in receipt of the Government's correspondence of last Friday, seeking a stay of Your Honor's Order with regard to redacting certain language from the transcripts of *ex parte* proceedings conducted by the Court in the above-referenced matter. As Your Honor knows, Plaintiffs were not permitted to be present for such proceedings and have no way of knowing what was and was not redacted. Accordingly, though we might well have a position with regard to the redactions if we were aware of them, and although we favor the broadest possible release of such information without disclosing classified material, as we know the Court does, we take no position on the Government's request for a stay, because we cannot do so based upon our current knowledge. This should not, of course, be viewed as any kind of admission or concession with regard to either the underlying merits or the Court's transcript redactions.
